MUNICIPAL INFORMATION - IMPORTANT DATES

- First payment of 2018 taxes is payable before April 5, 2018;
- Household garbage - weekly pick-ups will start on April 3rd;
- Pick-ups of the recycling remain every two weeks;
- Pickup of big pieces will start on April 25th, 2018;
- Removable shelters (Tempo) and snow fences must be removed no later than April 30th;
- Dump opening season will start on May 5th, 2018;
- Leaf collection will start on May 9th, 2018;
- Firefighters' brunch will be held on May 20th from 9 am to 1 pm at the Community Center. The costs are \$ 12 / adults and \$ 6 / children (6 to 12 years). Free for 5 years old and under.
